

Continuing Education Grants Overview

The Purpose of the Continuing Education Grants...

... is to make continuing education more available for active clergy who serve in the Episcopal Church of New Hampshire, with the intention of helping to develop and strengthen their personal, professional and spiritual growth.

The Continuing Education Committee's Work...

... is to support individual clergy in their continuing education, and through this means to enrich the overall ministry of the Church of New Hampshire. Also, the Committee seeks to publicize and promote continuing education for individual clergy.

The Committee evaluates grant requests and provides funds for a number of continuing education opportunities. Some notable examples are:

- Conferences
- Retreats
- Preaching seminars
- Seminary courses
- CREDO

How to apply for a Continuing Education Grant...

... Complete a Continuing Education Grant Application and send it electronically to the Chair of the Continuing Education Committee. Applications are reviewed on a first come, first served basis and are awarded throughout the year until funds are exhausted. Grants are generally awarded to an individual recipient no more often than once every three years.
